

There are two train lines that make up the Morris & Essex Line. The Morristown Line runs from Hackettstown to New York Penn Station. The Gladstone Branch runs from Gladstone to Hoboken Terminal. Passengers can transfer at Newark Broad Street Station or Summit Rail Station to change rail lines. Connections to PATH and Ferry service can be made at Hoboken Terminal.

\$ COST

The fare is based on the distance traveled. Tickets can be purchased from the vending machine located on the platform.

Riders can purchase tickets aboard the train without penalty only if there is no ticket agent or ticket vending machine available. A \$5 surcharge is applied to tickets purchased aboard trains if a ticket agent or ticket vending machine is available at the time of boarding.

Mobile ticketing is also available using the MyTix app from the App Store or Google Play.

Customers with disabilities and senior citizens (age 62 and older) may purchase tickets aboard any train without penalty. Conductors cannot accept bills larger than \$20.

The bus leaves from the new park and ride lot located in the parking deck of Building 300 of the Warren Corporate Center off King George Road. Park and ride hours are limited to 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday–Friday.

There is no fee for parking, but a permit is required.

Warren residents must show proof of residency. Permits can be obtained by calling the Clerk's office at 908-753-8000 ext. 223 or by emailing creese@warrennj.org. Parking placards must be placed on the rear-view mirror and be clearly visible to the police.
